The SHRC actively participates in community events, facilitates public forums and conducts public outreach to drive awareness, education and advocacy around human rights issues affecting our community.

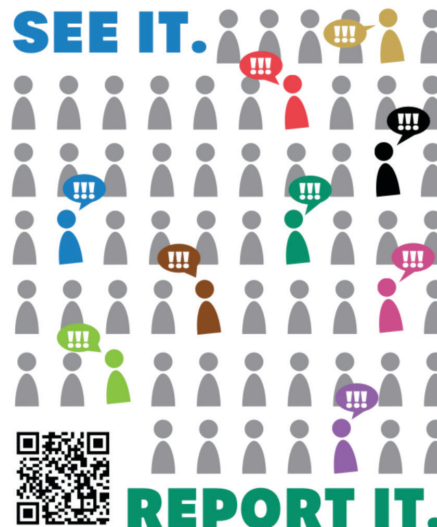
